COMMUNITY, SPORT AND LEISURE

Having considered reports contained in the agenda for a meeting of the Policy Advisory Group (PAG) held on 21 November 2002 and the views of the PAG expressed at the meeting, the Cabinet Member has made the following decisions.

1. **COMMUNITY GRANTS**

The Cabinet Member has approved community grants as follows:

Stoke Poges Parish Council	
Portable changing accommodation	£2,000
Burnham High Street Traders Association	
Christmas lighting	£1,000
Wexham Parish Council	
New Parish noticeboard	£431

(Note: A report on an application for a community grant from Iver Parish Council was also considered by the PAG. As a member of Iver Parish Council the Cabinet Member had a prejudicial interest in the matter which prevented him from taking a decision on the application, which will be passed to the Leader/Cabinet to decide).

2. **CHANGES TO PROPOSED FEES AND CHARGES 2003/04 - FARNHAM PARK GOLF COURSE**

The Cabinet Member has approved amendments to the proposed fees and charges at Farnham Park Golf course that have been previously recommended as follows:

- a) introduction of a 27 hole fee of £19.50 and £27 (for weekdays and weekends respectively) for society bookings.
- b) introduction of a day rate for golf to be used for promotional purposes.
- c) raising of the junior age from 16 to 18 in line with local sports centres and clubs.
- d) Amending the junior holiday pass into a whole year pass valid for weekdays and weekends after 12 noon (and at any time for The Lanes).

3. **COMMUNITY TRANSPORT**

Consideration of a report on possible future developments in the provision of community transport and concessionary fares has demonstrated the need to carry out further investigation into the options, sources of funding and potential working partners. The Cabinet Member has decided to give priority to consideration of improvements to Dial-A-Ride prior to re-tendering of the service for a new contract from 1 April 2003.
