Having considered a report contained in the agenda of a meeting of the Policy Advisory Group (PAG) held on 25 September 2003 and the views of the PAG expressed at the meeting, the Cabinet Member has made the following decision.

1. **YOUTH & KEY WORKER HOUSING NEEDS**

The Cabinet Member has decided to **RECOMMEND** the Cabinet that:

- (1) a housing needs survey for young people and key workers be commissioned at an estimated cost of £20,000;
- (2) the Council collaborates on a countywide key worker need survey, devising a common definition of key workers, to prepare a joint strategy, taking into account the travel to work patterns of key workers, which would contribute to the Buckinghamshire Community Plan priority for maintaining a dynamic economy; and
- (3) in order to fund the works, revenue resources be utilised that are allocated to contribute to building maintenance works in the capital programme, and to fund the building works from capital receipts no longer required to fund stamp duty costs of affordable housing projects following the abolition of LASHG.
