A. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1 To review the operation of the emergency recording fund.

3 The current balance is £4650, of which £1500 is committed to recording New Inn Farm, Stowe. £1300 contributions for 2005/6 are awaited.

D. SUPPORTING INFORMATION

5 Invoices have been issued for 2005/6 to all contributing members. This excludes Chiltern District Council.

6 In August, damage was reported to an unscheduled mound (a possible windmill mound) next to the Buckingham Arms in Maids Moreton. This has revealed a stone surface, pottery and other finds indicative of medieval occupation. If consent can be obtained from the landowner then it is proposed to undertake recording of exposed features prior to controlled reburial.
