## Extract (paragraphs 5 & 6) from the Leader's report to Cabinet on 30 July 2001

- 5. One outstanding issue that I am inviting the Cabinet to consider today concerns the Select Committee for the Environment's proposals for the future of Local Committees. The Committee's specific recommendations on short-term improvements are being followed up by the Area Co-ordinators, but there remains an issue of principle on which the Cabinet's advice is sought: whether the long-term aim should be to broaden the role and remit of local committees, and if so how this might be achieved.
- 6. If the Cabinet is minded to recommend to the Council that the scope of these committees is broadened, it could either commission some work itself and ask for a report from the Chief Officer on options, or it could ask the Overview and Scrutiny Committee to undertake further work to develop such options.
