The meeting, which is open to the public, will be held on Tuesday, 20th April 2004 at Wycombe District Council Chamber at 10.30 a.m. and will conclude latest 1 p.m. Cllr.  - iv. Relevant to the people of Buckinghamshire

The committee will seek to reach a consensus in its views. However, if this is not possible, areas of difference will be identified.
