Recommendation	The School Organisation Committee is asked to DETERMINE the statutory notices.
Resources Appraisal	There are no financial implications arising directly from this report.
Summary	Following the publication of statutory notices proposing changes in standard numbers at certain schools in Buckinghamshire, to request the Committee to determine the notices which will then take effect from September 2002.

Supporting Information

Proposals relating to a change in standard number for several Buckinghamshire schools were published earlier in the Spring. Copies of the proposals have previously been circulated to all members of the Committee. **(Members are asked to bring those papers with them to the meeting in order that appropriate consideration leading to a decision on the individual notices can take place.)**

Statutory objections to three of the proposals: that relating to High Ash CE Combined School, where it is proposed to increase the standard number from 22 to 30, to Great Kingshill CE Combined School, where it is proposed to increase the standard number at 4+ from 33 to 45 and to reduce the standard number from 30 to 20 at 7+ and to Stone CE Combined School where it is proposed to increase the standard number at 4+ from 25 to 28 and reduce the standard number from 12 to 6 at 7+ have been received. Copies of the relevant correspondence are attached.

Otherwise no statutory objections to the other proposals have been received by the time of the close of the objection period.
