PROPOSED CHANGE TO STANDARD NUMBER -
STONE CE COMBINED SCHOOL

The governors of Dinton Church of England School ^{wish to} ~~which~~ make comments regarding the change to the proposed standard number at Stone School at age 7.

Children living in the catchment area of Dinton School have Stone School as their designated school for transfer at Year 3.

Although in recent years the school has sent only small numbers of pupils at age seven, Dinton schools intake has been steadily increasing. We now take a significant number of pupils on entry to the school from the new estates situated between Dinton and Stone. These children along with children from Dinton, Ford and Upton may well choose Stone as their preferred junior school. A standard intake number of 6 pupils at 7 years would severely limit Stone School's ability to fulfil their responsibility to the children living in the parish of Dinton, especially those families wishing to continue with a church school education.

I hope that the committee will consider the future requirements of the children of Dinton School when considering the changes in the standard number at Stone.
