Summary	To report on the outcome from the formal statutory consultation period on proposals to amalgamate Greenway Infant School and William Durrant Junior School, Chesham to create one 210 place combined school .
Recommendation	That the Statutory Notice published on 19 January 2001 in respect of Greenway Infant and William Durrant Junior Schools, Chesham, having come to the expiry of the objection period, should be determined by the Local Education Authority.

b) discontinue William Durrant Junior School with effect from 31 August 2002	
c) establish a new school on the site of William Durrant Junior School,	

was made by the Education Authority on 19 January 2001 through the publication of statutory notices along with relevant supporting information.

The objection period came to an end on 19 March 2001 with no objections being received.

Accordingly, it is for the Local Education Authority to determine the notices without further reference to third parties.

As a matter of courtesy and information, however, the outcome of the formal statutory consultation will be reported to the next meeting of Buckinghamshire's School Organisation Committee.
