Summary

To bring to the Committee, statutory proposals in relation to the change of category of Marlow CE Infant School to Aided status. These proposals have been consulted upon and the statutory objection period is now finished. Proposals relating to the change of category from Voluntary Controlled to Voluntary Aided status for Marlow CE Infant School were published on 12 October 2001by the Governing Body through the publication of statutory notices along with relevant supporting information and are proposed to take effect from 1 April 2002. A pack of documents relating to these proposals containing a copy of the statutory notice, the prescribed information and the consultation document were sent to all members of the School Organisation Committee in October.

The formal objection period closed on 12 December 2001. Whilst no statutory objections were received before the end of that period, as the proposals are from governors they must be determined by the Committee.

The published proposals conform with the requirements of <u>Section 28 School Standards and</u> <u>Framework Act 1998</u> (as modified by the <u>Education (Change of Category of Maintained</u> <u>Schools) (England) Regulations 2000</u>) and the supporting documents include the information prescribed in the said 2000 Regulations.

The relevant guidance from the DfEE 'Guidance on Statutory Proposals' can be found on pages 103 – 105 of that document.

Recommendation

The School Organisation Committee is asked to determine the Statutory Notice.
