Summary

To bring to the Committee a statutory proposal relating to a change in standard number for High Wycombe CE Combined School which has been consulted upon and for which the statutory objection period has now finished.

The Committee is asked to determine the Statutory Notice.
(With reference to the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 Schedule 23 para. 7.)

Recommendation

Approval be given to the Statutory Notice relating to change in standard number at High Wycombe CE Combined School from 35 to 30 at 4+ with effect from September 2003.

Supporting Information

The Statutory Notice relating to High Wycombe CE Combined School was published by the governing body on 6 September 2002. The proposals relate to a change in standard number (and therefore the relevant admission arrangements) with effect from September 2003. The proposal is to change the standard number from 35 (4+) to 30. This will assist the school in the management of infant class sizes. The objection period closed on 6 November 2002.

No statutory objections to the proposals had been received at the time of the close of the objection periods.
