Summary

To bring to the Committee a statutory proposal relating to a change in age range for Thomas Hickman Combined School from 4 - 11 years to 3 - 11 years which has been consulted upon and for which the statutory objection period has now finished.

The Committee is asked to determine the Statutory Notice. (With reference to the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 Schedule 6 para. 4(5).)

Recommendation

Approval be given to the Statutory Notice relating to the change in age range at Thomas Hickman Combined School from 4-11 years to 3-11 years with effect from 1 January 2003 by providing a nursery for a maximum of 40 three year old children.

Supporting Information

The Statutory Notice relating to Thomas Hickman Combined School was published by the LEA on 9 August 2002. The proposals relate to changes with effect from 1 January 2003. The objection period closed on 9 October 2002.

No statutory objections to the proposals had been received at the time of the close of the objection period.
