to make a prescribed alteration to Sir William Ramsay School, Rose Avenue, Hazlemere, High Wycombe, HP15 7UB by the addition of provision reserved for pupils with Special Educational Needs.

The following proposals are made for this purpose:

- (a) With effect from 1 September 2004 a SEN provision for a Hearing Impaired Unit to accomodate15 pupils will be established at the school.
- (b) Hearing Impaired pupils are currently placed outside the LEA schools. Once the unit is established the LEA will be able to place pupils within its boundary.

The number of pupils to be admitted to the school at age 11+ at the start of the school year 1 September 2004 and at the start of each subsequent school year, is 165. The current number of pupils to be admitted to the school will not change.

Within six weeks after the date of publication of these proposals, any person may object to or make comments on the proposals by sending the representations to

Within one month after the end of the representation period, the LEA will send to the School Organisation Committee for the area copies of all representations made (and not withdrawn in writing) within the representation period, together with the Authority's observations on them.
