## Explanatory Notes

### Type of care:

Sessions offer a range of stimulating activities and play opportunities for children in a safe and secure environment, are a valuable resource for working parents, and for children participating for purely recreational pleasure.

**After School Clubs:** run from the end of the school day until a parent collects their child/ren - usually about 5.00/6.00 pm.

**Integrated Care:** run either before or after (or both) the 2.5 hours nursery educational session for 3 & 4 year olds.

For funding purposes, out of school childcare only includes children in full-time or part-time education.

### Number of children and Age of children:

Please only include children who you would like to attend the provision who are or will be in full-time or part-time education.

### Special Needs and Ethnic Origin:

This information is needed to ensure that the provision would cater for the whole of the local community adhering to equal opportunities legislation.

### Would the provision help you to?

This information forms part of the market research and would help to understand to see how such Provision would support parents in the local community.

### What childcare do you currently use?

Any provision developed is intended to complement, not compete with existing provision. This information will help to establish whether there is a need for childcare within the catchment area of our school. Some parents may be using friends and family but would prefer formal childcare.
