



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with Sections 28 (2)(b) of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 ("the 1998 Act") that Twyford C of E School Governors intend:-

To make a prescribed alteration to Twyford C of E School, Church Street, Twyford, Bucks MK18 4EU, by changing the school's age range from 4-9 years to 3 – 9 years so that 3 year olds can join the existing Foundation Stage class in September 2004.

The following proposals are made for this purpose:

- (a) that with effect from 1st September 2004 the age range of the school will change from 4 – 9 years to 3 – 9 years.
- (b) The capacity of the school in September 2004 will be 88. The number of pupils to be admitted to the main school at age 5 in September 2004 and subsequent years will be 18.
- (c) The current admission number of the pupils to be admitted to the school is 18 and the current capacity is 88. In January 2005 the capacity will be 108.
- (d) This provision within the school will serve the area currently served by Twyford C of E School catchment area using Governors admission criteria.

In accordance with paragraph 2 of the Schedule 6 of the 1998 Act and regulation 7(2)(a) of the Education (School Organisation Proposals) (England) regulations 1999 within the period of six weeks after the publication of these proposals any person may send their objection or comment on the proposals to the School Organisation Committee c/o Mr R Popat, Secretary to the SOC, County Hall, Bucks HP20 1UA. Explanatory Notes

- 1. These proposals will give effect to the wishes of the Governing Body of Twyford C of E School.
- 2. In the period up to 1st September 2004 pupils will be admitted to Twyford C of E School in accordance with existing arrangements.
- 3. With the agreement of the School Organisation Committee, it may be possible for objectors to make representations in person.
