3. IVINGHOE CONSERVATION AREA DESIGNATION

Ivinghoe Parish Council had commissioned this Council to review the Ivinghoe Conservation Area. The original designation had taken place in 1971. A copy of a map showing the proposed revised Conservation Area boundary was submitted. Copies of the draft Appraisal Document had been placed in the Members' Lounge. The Cabinet report summarised the legislation and guidance relating to the designation of Conservation Areas.

The Conservation Area Appraisal Document defined the special interest of Ivinghoe, identified those features which made Ivinghoe of sufficient interest to warrant designation, and laid out some settlement specific management proposals for the preservation and enhancement of the Conservation Area.

The proposed Conservation Area boundary at Ivinghoe had been drawn to include those elements and features which were considered to be of architectural or historic interest, or which positively contributed to the special character of the area as a whole. The report summarised the inclusions within the proposed Conservation Area

and incorporated a summary of the Management Plan, as well as a description of the consultation process and Officers' responses.

Cabinet was addressed by the Chairman of Ivinghoe Parish Council in support of the proposal and by an architect representing a local land owner seeking the exclusion of his client's property from the proposed Conservation Area.
