3 Supporting information

- 3.1 The attached report was submitted to the Environment and Living Scrutiny Committee on 13 June 2017 and provides an update on the Council's Climate Change Adaptation measures. Adaptation involves adjusting systems, processes or methods of working so as to increase the resilience to changes and risks posed by climate change.
- 3.2 The LCLIP (see appendix 2) is a document first produced in 2008. As the first district council LCLIP in the country at the time, it set out to assess the period 2000 to 2008 using archived news and local weather data for the Vale and North Bucks region.
- 3.3 The attached LCLIP is an update on this first LCLIP and sets out the continuing period 2008 to 2016.
- 3.4 The attached report and appendixes were considered by the Scrutiny Committee who were supportive of adaptations and work being done by the Council to increase the resilience to changes and risks posed by climate change.
- 3.5 Cabinet is asked to note the production of the updated LCLIP and agree to its publication on the Council's website.

4 Options considered

- 4.1 Not to produce an updated LCLIP. However, doing so will ensure that the Council continues to work towards addressing solutions to improve the Council's resilience to Climate Change, whilst recognising that the Sustainability resource has been reduced.
