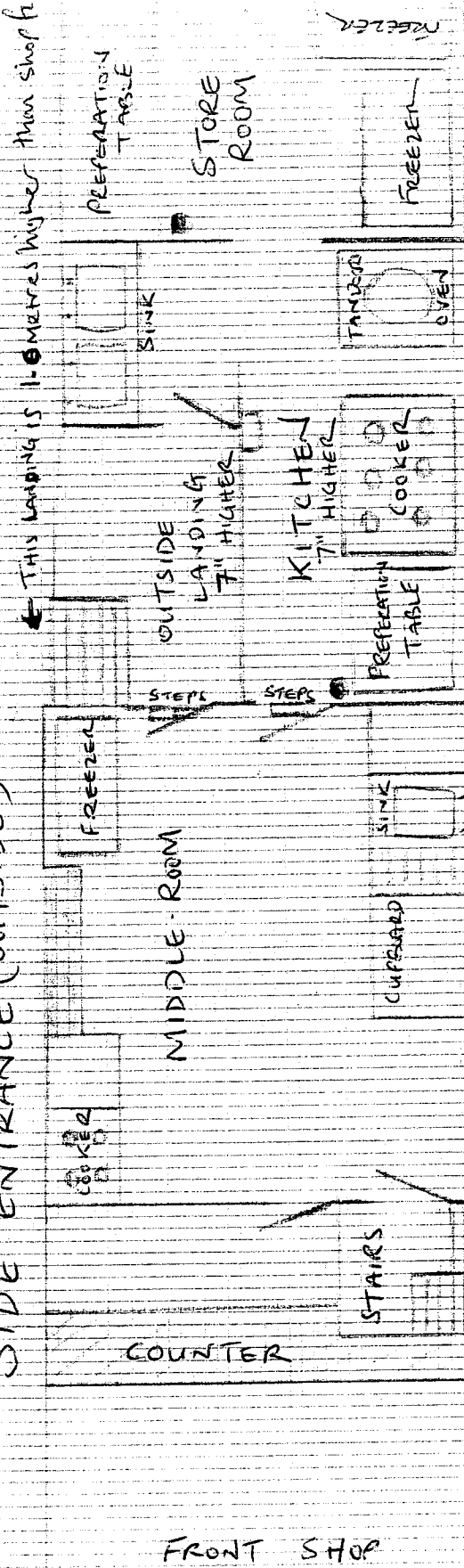

SIDE ENTRANCE (OUTSIDE)



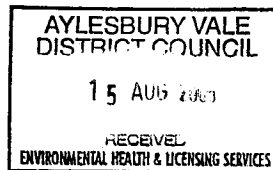
← THIS LANDING IS 1.6 METRES HIGHER THAN SHOP FLOOR

Re Premises Licence

Mr A Hussain from 39 Nelson Street Buckingham, has applied for a late night licence until 1 am in the morning. Currently, they are open from 5.30 – 11.30 pm. As their neighbours, we are not at all happy about this impending later hour licence because, the volume of car traffic and people traffic outside our home would ruin our peace and quiet in the evenings and would certainly prevent us from sleeping – when we should. Our lives would be unbearable in this context and definitely untenable!

Also, their delivery lorries, vans and articulated lorries always unload outside our home at least 5 evenings a week-(they never have deliveries in the daytime.) We are a listed building in the conservation area in Buckingham and, have hitherto suffered structural cracks internal and external in our building. We have had problems with these vehicles unloading outside our house and on our doorstep for years, to the present time.

We hope you can understand our plight, and see fit to prevent this disaster waiting to occur!
