1. THE APPLICATION

Applicant(s): Punch Taverns Plc

Premises: Chandos Arms, 8 The Turnpike, Oakley, HP18 9QB

1.1 Conversion Application

No representations have been received from Thames Valley Police in respect to this application to convert the existing permissions to a Premises Licence. Therefore in accordance with the transitional provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 the application to convert the existing permissions has been granted under delegated powers subject to any existing statutory restrictions and conditions and any other conditions which currently apply.

Attached as Appendix 1 is a copy of the completed application form, the designated premises supervisor consent form and a copy of the justices' licence. A plan of the premises will be made available at the Sub-Committee hearing.

1.2 Variation application

Both myself and my husband are concerned about the effect on our lives, and many of the residents of Oakky, should the two named pubs above, apply for, and are given an extension of their licensing hours.

licensees' applications go in, as it is quite likely in the six months from Jeb 7th - Auf 7th I could easily miss seeing their notification in one of the local papers. I could also miss any notice displayed on the premises because a) I am not a regular of either of the pubs, and b) even if the notice was displayed on their doors - both pubs are set well back from the road, and I am quite likely to have missed the right to object in the following 28 days.

the licensees of the two named pubs might wish to make — whether it be for 12.00 midnight closing or 24 hr opening —

are as follows.

The Chandos Arms

A-The close proximity of our house to the pub.

i. The back wall of our house being only 2 metres from the pub car park, and the front wall of thouse being only 4.5 metres away from the pavement the customers walk home on.

B- Noise from car park - which is directly under our back bedroom windows. Windows, which in spite of new double glazing have to be taghtly closed, energen Summer.

1. The loud voices as they make their way to the cars.

2. The inevitable slamming of cardoots.

4. The loud music which often starts up with the ignition key.

3. Friday rights - earliest closing 12.30 am - but often much much later - can be 1:00 am - 2.00 am or even later. Sunday night - average closing time midnight or later as is the rest of the week.

The Royal Oak - approx. 100 metres from our house.

Noise

1. Loud voices from late right pub leavers as oney walk past the front of our house on the way home

2. Occasional very loud music from hised marquee until 2 am.

There are thousands of people all over the country who wond even know they have a right to object, a) because their never been told on b) because they wont have seen any applications, until it is too late. In a 2 minute slot on local news about the new licensing laws, no information was given as to how a person could object - when they could object or even to whom they could object. It will all he accomplished without most people even being aware they had a right to object. ANDC'S decision to longer send out draft regulations to Parish Councils was unfordunate. As was said on the news reparding licensing - "Police don't want it - one residents don't want it" - and the general public are not being correctly informed about it.
