

**REPORT ON APPLICATION FROM THE RED

**1. THE APPLICATION**

Applicant(s): Fullers, Smith and Turner plc

Premises: Red Lion, Buckingham Road, Little Tingewick, Buckingham,  
MK18 4AG

**1.1 Conversion Application**

No representations have been received from Thames Valley Police in respect to this application to convert the existing permissions to a Premises Licence. Therefore in accordance with the transitional provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 the application to convert the existing permissions has been granted under delegated powers subject to any existing statutory restrictions and conditions and any other conditions which currently apply.

Attached as Appendix 1 is a copy of the completed application form, the designated premises supervisor consent form and a copy of the justices' licence. A plan of the premises will be made available at the Sub-Committee hearing.

- 2) Fullers operate traditional high quality public houses selling award winning cask ale, good wine and excellent food. There is no intention to deviate from this during the extended hours of operation. The additional hours will themselves promote the licensing objectives particularly in relation to crime and disorder and public nuisance as stated in paragraph 3.29 of the guidance by allowing customers to emerge from the premises at a more gradual rate.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

- 1) We have carefully considered the risks and benefits associated with the extra hours applied for and we believe that because of the character of the premises, and its location, no additional measures are necessary.
