1. THE APPLICATION

1.1 Conversion Application

No representations have been received from Thames Valley Police in respect to this application to convert the existing permissions to a Premises Licence. Therefore in accordance with the transitional provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 the application to convert the existing permissions has been granted under delegated powers subject to any existing statutory restrictions and conditions and any other conditions which currently apply.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We have an ADT security system so the premises are alarmed. There are two registered key holders who the Police can call if necessary. The gaming machines have special cages which are locked after each session. The Club Steward lives on the premises. There are sensor lights around the premises which light up if we have an intruder. We would like to introduce CCTV. We have a members door system with intercom facility which prevents access of non members. We are a member of P.I.B. watch.

c) Public safety

We have complied with all existing conditions regarding fire extinguishers, annual attendance of Chubb fire, numbers limits and fire exits. Only authorised people are allowed in the bar and kitchen area. We have had no public safety problems to date. All fire exits are lit up with signs.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

We have had no problems or complaints regarding public nuisance due to location of premises well away from residential areas.

e) The protection of children from harm

We will request that all children under 18 are to be accompanied by an adult and kept under strict supervision. We intend to place a sign up to this effect. Furthermore, admission of all children (as accompanied) under 18 to be entirely at the discretion of the management on any event.
