

**REPORT ON APPLICATION FROM THE
GREYHOUND MARSH GIBBON UNDER THE
LICENSING ACT 2003 FOR CONVERSION AND
VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE**

1. THE APPLICATION

Applicant(s): Mr Richard Kaim

Premises: The greyhound, Marsh Gibbon, Oxfordshire, OX27 0HA

1.1 Conversion Application

No representations have been received from Thames Valley Police in respect to this application to convert the existing permissions to a Premises Licence. Therefore in accordance with the transitional provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 the application to convert the existing permissions has been granted under delegated powers subject to any existing statutory restrictions and conditions and any other conditions which currently apply.

Attached as Appendix 1 is a copy of the completed application form, the designated premises supervisor consent form and a copy of the justices' licence. A plan of the premises will be made available at the Sub-Committee hearing.

I write with reference to your letter dated 4th August 2005 concerning the above premises. I subsequently telephoned you on 11th August 2005 and left a message, but note that to date you have not replied.

I would be grateful if you could respond to the following queries that I have:

- (1) Within Section F (Recorded music) you request that music be played internally up until midnight on Thursday and Sunday, and 01:00 hours on all other evenings. You additionally propose to serve alcohol until midnight Sunday to Thursday, and 01:00 hours on Friday and Saturday, with an hour on top of these times for 'drinking up'. These discrepancies in times will result in music being played only during the hours of alcohol supply on Thursday to Sunday, whilst music continues to the end of drinking up times on Monday to Wednesday. Whilst I do not have a specific representation in relation to this discrepancy I would like to clarify if this application reflects the times and occasions that the applicant would actually wish to have such entertainment.
- (2) Within the plan that accompanies the application you indicate that alcohol will only be supplied and consumed internally within the premises. I do however note that the premises has benches externally for customer use. Please can you confirm whether you propose to use these external areas for alcohol consumption, or any other activity (such as the supply of food). If you do propose to use the external areas please can you clarify at what time customers will be requested to move indoors and thus reduce noise levels.
- (3) On page 24 of the application, within Section Q(d), the prevention of public nuisance, you state that noise will be inaudible at any noise sensitive properties. Please can you clarify how you will ensure this is the case. For example do you propose to keep all doors and windows closed after a certain time




