1. THE APPLICATION

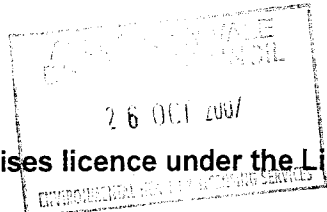



Dear Licensing Services Manager

We have seen a notice posted outside Wendover Memorial Hall which notifies that the Wendover Memorial Hall management committee have applied for an alcohol license and for an extension to the hours of opening of the hall. We wish to oppose both of these applications. We object, as near neighbours, on the grounds that the hall has functioned perfectly well without it for many years so this represents a change of use. We note that the hall is currently being marketed as a party and wedding reception venue but consider this an inappropriate use due to its close proximity to nearby homes.

As you are well aware, the hall is presently limited to a maximum of 12 occasions per annum when alcohol can be consumed. These occasions often cause nuisance and disturbance, particularly when run in conjunction with music and dancing. We do not want any increase in the number of events with alcohol served. We can see no good reason for extending the opening hours and therefore object to this on the same grounds whilst also pointing out the nuisance and disturbance generally caused by large numbers of people leaving an event at midnight and using the car park at that time.

Thank you for your letter dated 6th November with enclosures.

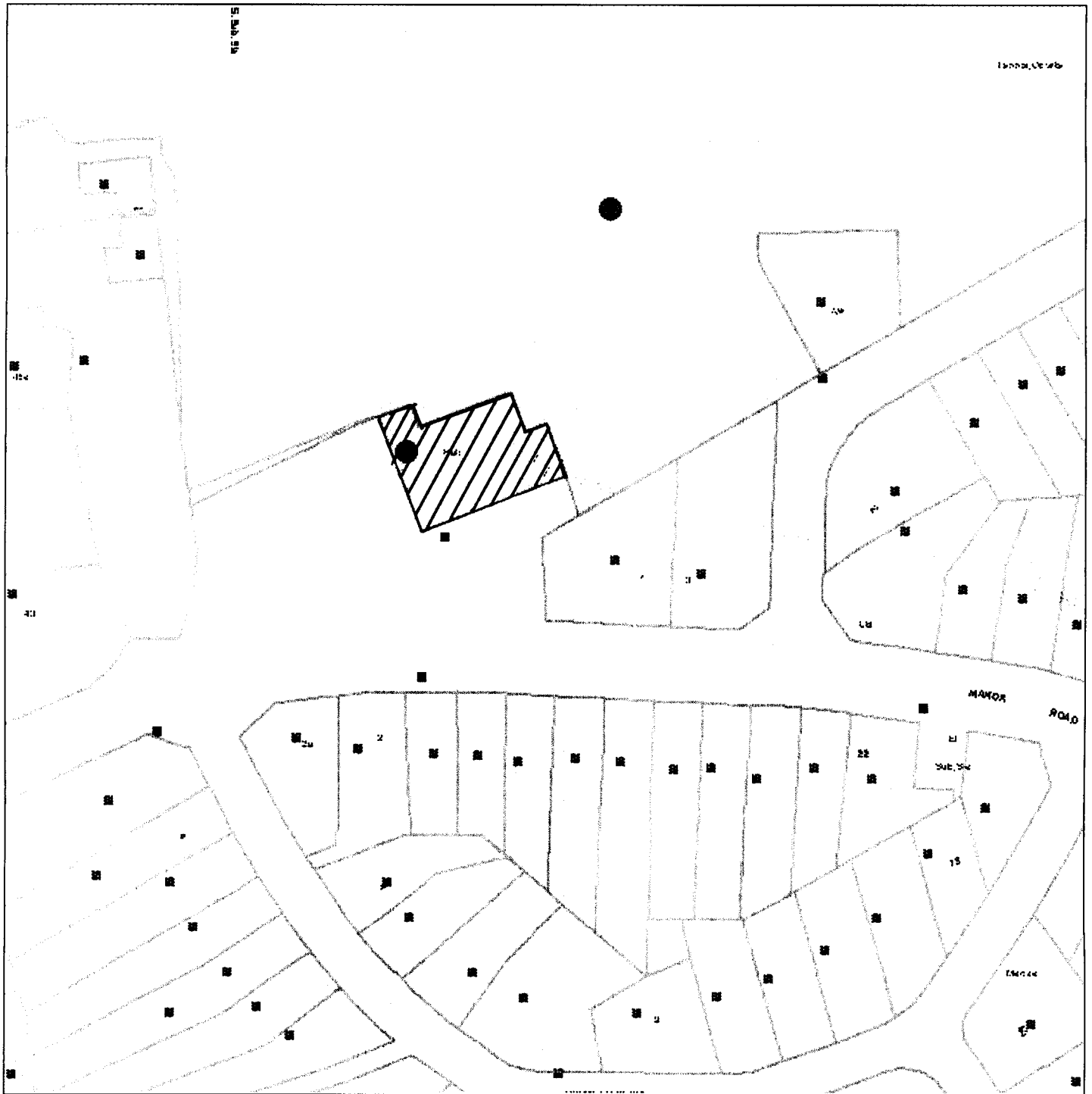
Unfortunately, we are unable to attend the hearing scheduled for 5th December as we will both be at work at that time. However, we do not have anything substantially different to say than the points made in our previous communication - which is that we consider it inappropriate to alter the license already in place due to the siting of the hall in a predominantly residential area. Reading through the application it was not clear where "amend opening hours of premises" was being invoked. In the category "prevention of public nuisance" we were pleased to see the prohibition of 18th and 21st birthday parties but do not consider this is sufficient. We consider all private hire occasions for parties and celebrations potentially cause as much nuisance as the parties mentioned - this would include all birthday parties, weddings, anniversaries etc. This is because all such occasions typically have music and dancing and the volume invariably increases during the evening. We feel that with the attraction of an alcohol licence, this nuisance could occur every weekend. This is why we would wish the number of occasions limited to 12.
