

**REPORT ON APPLICATION FROM  
AYLESBURY RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB  
WESTON TURVILLE UNDER THE LICENSING  
ACT 2003 FOR A PREMISES LICENCE TO BE  
GRANTED (TIME LIMITED 25<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2011- 25<sup>TH</sup>  
JUNE 2011)**

**1. THE APPLICATION**

Applicant(s): Buckinghamshire County Council

Premises: Aylesbury Rugby Football Club, Ostlers Field, Brook End, Weston Turville, Buckinghamshire, HP22 5RN

**1.1 New Application**

The application is for a new Premises Licence under section 17 of the Act. The detail in respect to the hours and activities applied for are set out in the application form, attached as Appendix 1.

The steps the applicant intends to take to promote the licensing objectives are set out in the operating schedule (see appendix 1, Part P of application form).

The applicant has produced an Event Safety Management Plan which forms part of the operating schedule as this is subject to change the final copy will be made available at the hearing.

In an effort to clarify the proposed permissions these are set out in Appendix 2. A location plan is attached as Appendix 4. A site plan will be made available at the hearing.

The event will be a 1 day music festival held at Aylesbury Rugby Football Club, Weston Turville for a maximum of 9,999 people.

The event will open to the public at 11.00 on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> June. The event is a one off event for National Armed Forces Day the event will run from 11.00am – 11.45pm with live music, dance exhibitions and an air display.
