We will be operating a cafe like hot food establishment which encourages food to be consumed on the premises, thereby minimising litter, nuisance and providing a set up that is not available ~~at~~ at the moment. These premises are relatively large and airy providing an ambience like a cafe.

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We will not be serving any restricted products, or like alcohol. We ~~will~~ have a policy of not admitting abusive or alcohol affected customers. We will be in constant contact with the local PCSO to ensure good practice and to be aware of any local issues.

All staff are highly experienced, while the management has many years of experience of ownership and operating food establishments. There will be a minimum of 2 (two) staff at all times but usually more.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

We will display notices: 1) asking customers to leave queues
2) respect the neighbourhood

Re New application for premises licence to be known as "Khzan Baba,s.

I refer to the above application and after consultation with the area commander and local police officers report as follows..

This application is on the site of a restaurant that shut many months ago. The restaurant was no problems to the police and shut at a reasonable hour.

The hours being asked for are consistent with others within the town centre and some in the near vicinity. They are also very close to two others that operate up to 5am.

The applicant has put in place a number of conditions that may help local people when his customers leave, and his plans show that he would concentrate on sit down customers.

However although there is no evidence to show that his customers will add to any noise nuisance in the area I am aware that it does exist and with the other late night premises near by I can see that this nuisance could be extended to an earlier hour as most alcohol lead premises in the town will have closed at this time and customers will be looking for food.

I would recommend that the hours of operation for this premises be reduced to 2.25 late night refreshment and 2.30 close Monday to Saturday.

I have reviewed the plans and information sent to the Environmental Health Division.

The proposed opening times (1200 – 0325 Mon – Fri, 1200 – 0335 Sat and 1200 – 0025 Sun) are approximately consistent with the opening times of other food premises in the vicinity and are significantly shorter than two nearby premises that are licensed to open until 5am.

I note that the applicant will be displaying notices asking customers to leave quietly, to respect the neighbourhood and to dispose of litter responsibly. The applicant also states that staff will carry out regular litter picks in the immediate vicinity of the premises.

A complaint about litter, noise and anti-social behaviour has recently been received by Environmental Health regarding premises on Cambridge Street, however the complaint concerns the area as a whole rather than specific premises. I have noted that 179 Cambridge Street does have indoor seating and toilet facilities for customers. This is likely to encourage people to stay inside the premises while eating and may therefore help to reduce the numbers of people gathering outside in this area.

Based on the information given I do not wish to object to this application.

The council, and licensing committee have previously acknowledged that late night kebab shops in this area have contributed to public disorder. Despite the environmental health and AVDC licensing denying all knowledge, the residents of Cambridge Street have sent petitions to AVDC against any new late night premises in this area due to the problems they can contribute to, this may have been sent to the planning and not distributed to all other relevant departments. We respectfully request that the council consider a policy of preventing any further late night licenses in this area to avoid creating a late night centre of attraction outside peoples homes. Late night revellers should be encouraged to disperse in all directions and not be directed to a single residential area where disturbance will be inevitable. I would also like to direct the licensing committee to the planning conditions that were imposed on the nearby property of 165 Cambridge street by the planning committee preventing late night opening (09/00545/APP), to allow late night opening on this property would be completely contradictory to this and further compound problems in this area.

I note the recent submissions regarding my application to open at late hours at the above premises. As I stated to you I am local man living off Cambridge Street so am fully aware of the area.

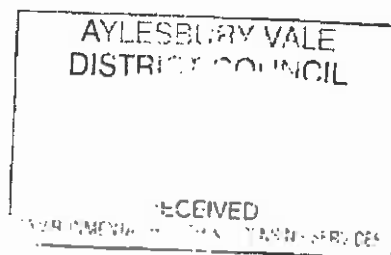
