

License application for Sainsbury at Jansel Square

Dear Sir,

I object to the license as mentioned above on the grounds that the anti-social behaviour by groups of teenagers that had existed has now largely been eradicated by the police actions over time. Any extension of the availability for alcohol is totally unnecessary as this will encourage young adults to congregate there. There is already another retail outlet that has a license less than 100 yards away, but this keeps more reasonable hours.

The hours that are requested by Sainsbury are totally out of keeping with this area, 7 am to 11pm daily including Sunday. I believe that this license, if granted, will cause public nuisance, and will do little to prevent young adults causing problems and putting their well- being at risk.
