

CABINET DECISION NOTICE

Tuesday 11 February 2020



The following decision(s) were taken by Cabinet at its meeting held on **Tuesday 11 February 2020** :-

1. LITTLE HORWOOD CONSERVATION AREA

(a) Decision(s)

- (1) That the responses to the consultation referred to in the Cabinet report (Appendix 1), be noted.
- (2) That the Conservation Area boundary, referred to in Appendix 2, option 1 in the Cabinet report, be adopted.
- (3) That the Management Plan be adopted.

(b) Reason(s) for Decision(s)

The Council is under a statutory obligation to review Conservation Area boundaries from time to time. The justification for approving option 1 is justified within the Conservation Area Appraisal document.

(c) Alternative Options Considered

- (1) To remove Hill Farm and adjacent fields to the west of Church Street, the paddocks between the moated site and Wood End and The Garden of Peace from the proposed designation but include the moated site within the Conservation Area. (referred to as option 2 in the Cabinet report)
- (2) To retain the existing 1991 Conservation Area boundary with only minor alterations to ensure that the boundary accurately followed extent boundaries. (referred to as option 3 in the Cabinet report)

The Cabinet report contained a commentary on both options. Cabinet was of the opinion that Option 1 should be approved.

(d) Relevant Scrutiny Committee
