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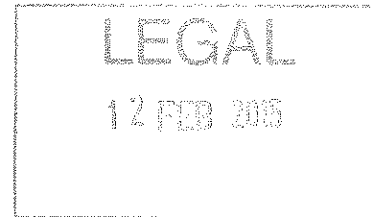

## **Pinner Green Adj to Blackwell Hall Lane, Latimer.**

I refer to your letter dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 2014 concerning the above area of land owned by this Council. I am sorry for the delay in responding.

Whilst the Council considers that its position set out in my email to Jonathan Clark dated 5<sup>th</sup> November 2014 is still valid, it does note the views of the Local Access Forum. After further deliberation, arrangements will be made to remove the barbed wire. The posts will, however, be left in place to continue to deter fly-tippers, a suggestion made by Kate Ashbrook in her email of 16<sup>th</sup> October 2014 to Jonathan Clark.

The Council will monitor the situation over the coming months and reserves the right to reconsider its options should fly-tipping become a problem again.
