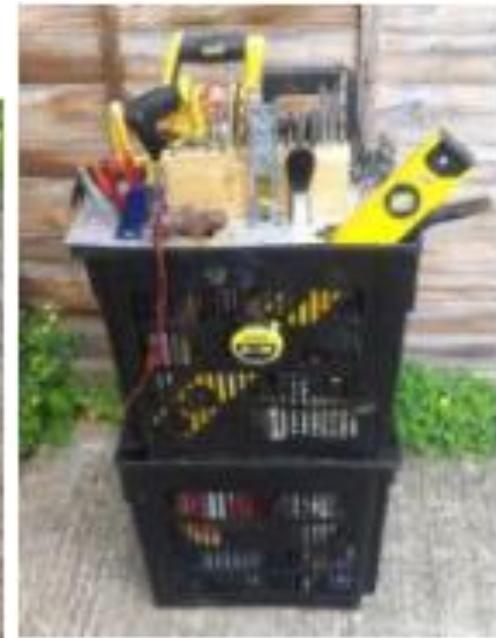



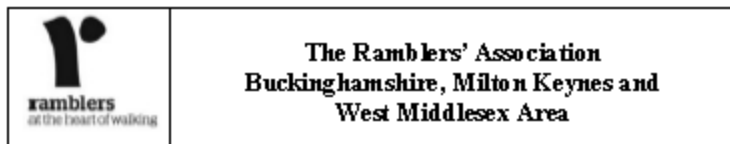

The scheme qualifies under Charity Gift Aid rules, whereby Ramblers can claim back tax from the Inland Revenue. Note: Gift Aid applies if you pay income tax or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax deducted from your donation.

If you cease to pay tax, please inform the scheme organiser. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further relief on your self-assessment form.

By signing this form I agree to the following terms and conditions:

- My donation does not bestow upon me any right of ownership of the gate unless I am the landowner.
- Maintenance of the gate is the responsibility of the landowner.
- As the gate donor, I am responsible for the maintenance of the plaque. (NB rRIPPLE will replace plaques if required. The cost of replacement plaques, around £25, will be borne by the donor.)
- The type of gate to be installed will be the most suitable for the location as determined by the Bucks County Council (BCC) Rights of Way Department. BCC prefers galvanised steel gates to timber gates and simple pedestrian gates over kissing gates.
- Gate locations will be determined/agreed by the BCC Rights of Way Department.
- NB rRIPPLE is unable to agree specific locations, but a list of locations for which permission has been obtained to install a gate can be supplied on request. However, any request for a specific location within North Bucks will be passed to the Bucks County Council Rights of Way Department.
- Gate installation will be completed as soon as possible as part of the normal NB rRIPPLE work programme.
- The scheme organiser will contact the donor to confirm the installation has been completed and the location of the gate.
- The Ramblers will be the sole arbitrator if an inscription is considered unsuitable by the scheme organiser.

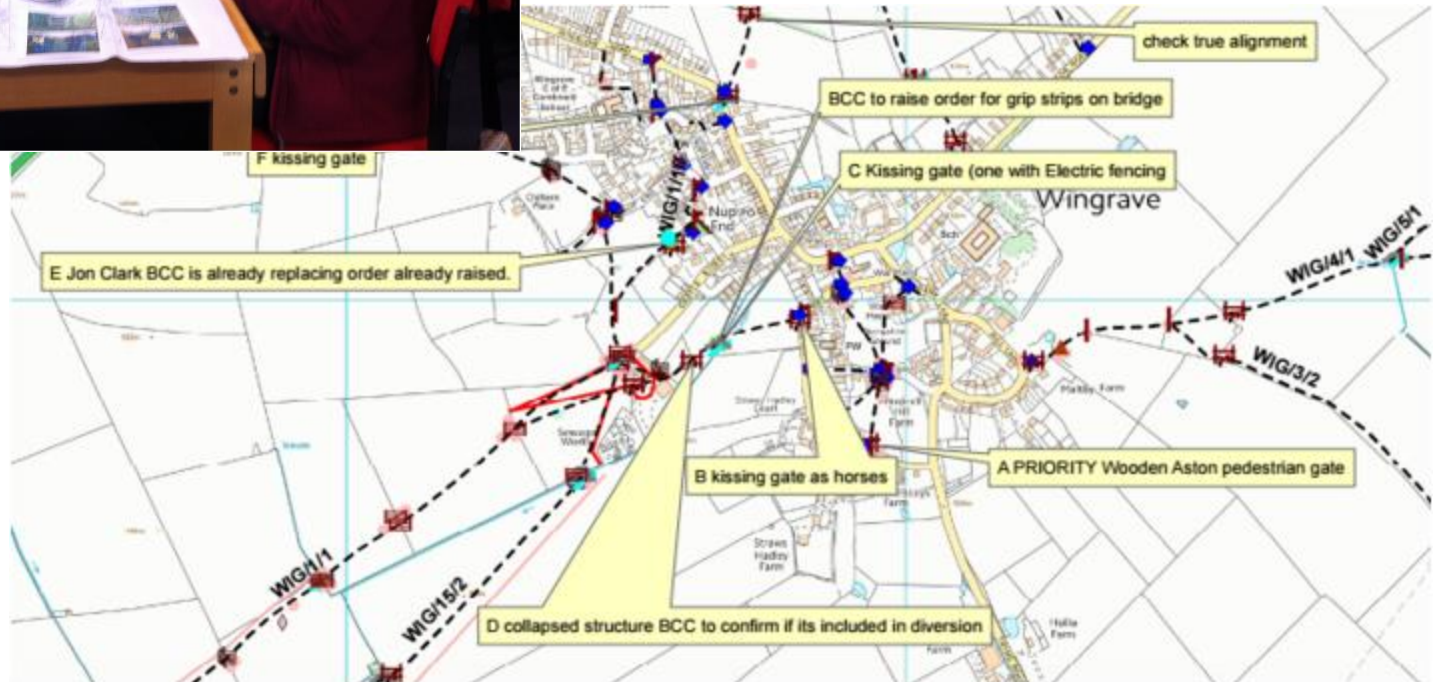

Potential number of DaGs

- Total number of stiles county wide is 4,846
- Total number of stiles in the AVDC area is 3,352 (70% of stiles are in the north of the county)
- Number of gates and kissing gates = 1,986
- Number of stiles in need of repair = Anybody's guess;
NB rRIPPLE guess = several hundred
