Summary

Burnham Upper School was inspected by Ofsted in March and was placed in the Special Measures category. The LEA wishes to appoint Mr Martin Baxter as an additional LEA governor to Burnham Upper School in accordance with the Standards and Framework Act 1998. Officers from the School Improvement Team recommend Mr Baxter for his extensive knowledge and experience in education.

Recommendation

That the Cabinet Member formally confirms the following recommendation

1. That approval be given for the appointment of Mr Martin Baxter as additional LEA Governor at Burnham Upper School. The additional LEA governor will help to ensure that the school implements and monitors the Ofsted Action Plan successfully so that Burnham Upper School will move from Special Measures category as soon as possible.

it was important to make the appointment as quickly as possible to provide support and ensure the school implements and monitors their Actions Plans successfully and therefore move from Special Measures category without delay.
