#### **Summary**

This report seeks approval for the Planning & Environment Service Plan for 2007/08.

#### Recommendation

That the Cabinet Members approve the Planning & Environment Service Plan for 2006/07.

#### A. Narrative setting out the reasons for the decision

 Service Plans are the formal process for setting out how the implications of the Medium Term Plan will be delivered at the service level. The plans set out in detail the priorities for each service to deliver and the measurable targets against which performance will be monitored.

- 2. The content of the Plan has been the subject of formal and informal consultation with Members and other interested partners including the Community Services PAG members, Strategic Planning PAG, Waste PAG, and the Environment Board andMTP process and Funding, Economic, External (FEE) PAG.
- 3. Customer feedback has been encouraged through a variety of methods including consultations on the South East Plan, the Waste Strategy and the Minerals and Waste Local Plan, user satisfaction surveys with Household Waste Centres, and forums and user groups to inform the Waste Strategy. All these consultations have contributed to informing and shaping the Planning & Environment Service Plan.
- 4. The Planning and Environment Service Plan covers work affecting three Portfolios:
  - Planning Portfolio: Strategic Planning
  - Community Services Portfolio: Countryside & Heritage Services, and Rights of Way & Access.
  - Deputy Leader: Economy & Enterprise
- 5. The full Service Plan, to be published by Planning & Environment, is available for viewing on the Intranet (http://intranet/svc\_spatial\_planning/whos\_who/main.htm). The abridged Service Plan, published corporately, is available on the Intranet via the Performance Software. Copies of both Service Plans are attached as Appendix 1.
- 6. The Deputy Leader, the Cabinet Member for the Community Services and the Cabinet Member for Planning Portfolios are invited to approve the Planning and Environment 2007/8 abridged Service Plan, following which it will be published on the County Council's website.
