Part 1

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 ("The Act"), that BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ("The LA") intend to make the following change(s):

In accordance with section 29(1) of the Act to discontinue Elmhurst Infant School, Dunsham Lane, Aylesbury, Bucks HP20 2DB with effect from 31 August 2007.

It is proposed that pupils currently attending the closing school will transfer onto the roll of the enlarged Elmhurst Junior School – see Part 2 below. Admission may also be sought to other schools which have places available.

The LA's current transport policy will apply – see Explanatory Notes below.

Within six weeks after the date of publication of the above proposals, any person may object to or make comments on the proposals by sending their representations to the Chief Education Officer, County Hall, Aylesbury, Bucks HP20 1 UZ quoting ref ELM/AT. Within one month after the end of the representation period, the LEA will send to the School Organisation Committee for the area copies of all objections and comments made (and not withdrawn in writing) within the representation period, together with the LA's observations on them.

Part 2

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 ("The Act") that the BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ("The LA") intend to make the following change(s):

In accordance with section 28(1) of the Act to make a prescribed alteration to Elmhurst Junior School, Dunsham Lane, Aylesbury, HP20 2 DB by:

- changing the age range of the school by a year or more from 01 September 2007
- an enlargement of the premises of the school with effect from 01 September 2007.

The current age range of the school is 7 years to 11 years .The proposed age range will be 4+ years to 11 years.

The current number of pupils at the school is 153. The current capacity of the school is 240. The proposed capacity of the enlarged school is to be 315.

The number of pupils to be admitted to the main school at age 4+ from 01 September 2007 and subsequent years will be 45.

It is proposed that from 1 September 2007, the former Elmhurst Junior School site will become a single-site primary school housing the 4 - 11 year olds.

Within six weeks after the date of publication of the above proposals, any person may object to or make comments on the proposals by sending their representations to – The chief Education Officer, County Hall, Aylesbury, Bucks HP20 1 UZ. Within one month after the end of the representation period the LA will send the School Organisation Committee for the area copies of all objections and comments made (and not withdrawn in writing) within the representation period, together with the LA's observations on them.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

1. These proposals will give effect to the wishes of the Governing Body of Elmhurst Infant and Junior Schools and the Local Authority.
2. In the period up to 20 July 2007 pupils will be admitted to Elmhurst Infant School, Aylesbury in accordance with existing arrangements.
3. With the agreement of the School Organisation Committee, it may be possible for objectors to make representations in person.
4. Details of Buckinghamshire County Council's policy on transport to schools are contained in the admissions to Primary and Secondary schools guide published by the LA every year. Advice on transport to schools is also obtainable from the School Organisation Team, County Hall, Aylesbury, HP20 1UZ.
