

## **Cuddington C of E School and Dinton C of E School**

This notice replaces the first notice published on 24 May 2007 and printed in the Bucks Herald on 30 May 2007 which has been withdrawn, to comply with new legislation that came into force on 25 May 2007.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the Education and Inspections Act 2006 ("The Act") that The Governing Body of Cuddington and Dinton Church of England Federated Schools (Voluntary Aided), Upper Church St. Cuddington, Bucks. HP18 0AP and School Lane, Dinton, Bucks. HP17 8UZ intend to make the following change(s):

### **Part 1**

In accordance with section 15(1) of the Act to discontinue Dinton C of E School, School Lane, Dinton, Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire, HP17 8UZ on 31 August 2008.

All statutory consultation requirements relating to this proposal have been complied with.

It is proposed that pupils currently attending the closing school will transfer onto the roll of the enlarged Cuddington C of E School - see Part 2a below. Admission may also be sought to other schools which have places available.

The LA's current transport policy will apply. Displaced pupils will remain on the current site as present infant aged children on roll will continue their infant education at the Dinton site.

### **Part 2**

In accordance with section 19(3) of the Act to make a prescribed alteration to Cuddington C of E School, Upper Church Street, Cuddington, Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire, HP18 0AP from 01 September 2008 by:

- a) changing the age range of the school by a year or more, and;
- b) enlarging the school premises.

The current age range of the school is 4 years to 7 years. The proposed age range will be 4 years to 11 years. The current capacity of the school is 60 and the proposed capacity will be 140. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 56. The proposed admission number for the school will be 20. The first intake of Year 3 pupils will be on 01 September 2008 and be the first year of juniors to progress through the school.

All statutory consultation requirements relating to this proposal have been complied with.

If these proposals are approved, from 1 September 2008, Cuddington C of E School will become a split-site primary school - the Cuddington site will house the infant department (capacity of 60) and the Dinton site, the junior department (capacity of 80) and the school will become the Cuddington and Dinton C of E School.
