- d) On Garratts Way near its junction with Hughenden Avenue
- e) On the junction of Coates Lane and Tancred Road
- f) On the junction of Kingston Road and Hobart Close
- g) On the junction of Healey Avenue and St George's Close
- h) On various lengths and junctions of Princes Gate
- i) On Bassetsbury Lane opposite The Rye car park access road
- j) On Keep Hill Road opposite Ryevue Manor
- k) On various lengths of Totteridge Drive between Kingston Road and East Drive
- l) On the junction of Totteridge Road and Denewood
- m) On the junction of Hillary Road and Everest Road
- n) On the junction of Hatter's Lane and The Roperies
- o) On the junctions of Kings Square, Beech Road and Ford Street
- p) On both junctions of Micklefield Road and Herbert Road
