The effect of the Order is to introduce sections of 'No waiting at any time waiting restrictions' (double yellow lines) on: -

- Hag Hill Lane, Burnham
- Hag Hill Rise, Burnham
- Cavendish Close, Burnham
- Hitcham Road, Burnham
- Windsor Lane, Burnham
- Lincoln Hatch Lane, Burnham

Statement of Reasons

Proposed 'No waiting at any time' restrictions

'No waiting at any time' (double yellow line) restrictions are to be imposed on roads:

- Hag Hill Lane, Burnham
- Hag Hill Rise, Burnham
- · Hitcham Road, Burnham
- Cavendish Close, Burnham
- Windsor Lane, Burnham
- Lincoln Hatch Lane, Burnham

for the following reasons:-

- 1. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- 2. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
- 3. For implementing requirements of the Highway Code.
