Decision To Be Taken

Recommendation

It is recommended that:

- a. The Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Transportation authorises the Service Director, Highways and Technical Services to make the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) for the scheme outlined in this report; noting that it is slightly different to the one that was advertised during the Statutory Consultation process because it takes into account the responses received during the consultation period.
- b. That the TRO be made as advertised at Statutory Consultation but with the following amendments:
 - Removal of proposed 'No waiting at any time' restrictions along the length of Cedar Avenue from Brimmer's Hill to the mid – point between Fox Field & The Warren however including junctions (Map ref Area Code: AG54 & AG55)
 - Reducing lengths of proposed 'No waiting at any time' restrictions on various junctions with Cedar Avenue – Implementing highway code



junction protections only – No parking within 10 meters of a junction (Double yellow lines) (Map ref Area Code: AG54 & AG55)

- Implementing 'No waiting at any time' restrictions on Cedar Avenue opposite Cedar Park School (on the inside bend) following notification during the statutory consultation that Thames Valley Police advise that vehicles should not park on the bend as this causes visibility issues
- Formalising of School keep clear marking outside of Cedar Park School
- c. That responders to the Statutory Consultation be informed of the Deputy Leader & Cabinet Member for Transportation Decision.
