Biography – Mr David Miles

For the past 30 years, David has had a wide range of executive leadership roles in the technology and telecommunications sector including IBM, Compaq and Motorola. He is currently FOSI's Director for Europe, Middle East and Africa. FOSI is an international non-profit organisation which works to make the online safer for kids and their families.

David is a member of the Executive Board of the UK Council for Child Internet Safety (UKCCIS), the British Government's principal advisory body for online safety for children and young people. Within UKCCIS, he chairs the Over Blocking Working Group. In addition, he is a member of the Internet Matters Expert Advisory Panel, an internet safety portal established by the UK's four leading ISPs.

David is a member of the United Nations ITU Child Online Protection (COP) Working Council based in Geneva and the European Commission's CEO's Coalition Stakeholder Group, as well as actively involved in a number of broader International initiatives related to online safety.

David is a Freeman of the Worshipful Company of Information Technologists, one of the City of London's livery companies and granted its Royal Charter in 2010.
