Decision

Approval to advertise a permanent Traffic Regulation Order

Reasons for the decision

1. Funding has been secured from the government's National Productivity Investment Fund (NPIF) to improve the pedestrian crossing facilities and carriageway layout on A41 Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury.
2. Proposals are in place to improve the carriageway layout, including modifying the single phase Toucan crossing to a staggered crossing on A41, Gatehouse Road immediately west of the A418 roundabout. In order to achieve this arrangement, the adjacent parking layby is to be removed and the resident parking bays relocated through extending the other adjacent existing laybys on A41 Gatehouse Road. The number of spaces is being maintained.

Authority to take this decision

Council scheme of delegation July 2015, TEE 3e.

Other options available, and their pros and cons

None – not relocating the crossing would prevent the crossing from being staggered whilst providing the necessary two eastbound lanes to the roundabout to maintain capacity and prevent unacceptable queues.

Statement of Reasons

Relocation of Resident Parking Bays

A41 Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury

Buckinghamshire County Council has proposed a new carriageway layout for A41, Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury as part of its Strategic Economic Plan to provide significant highway layout improvements network along the A418, Oxford Road. The changes to the carriageway layout will aim to provide traffic a staggered Toucan Crossing on A41, Gatehouse Road Aylesbury. In order to achieve this arrangement, it is proposed as part of the carriageway improvements that some of the Resident Parking bays are relocated without losing any vehicle capacity.

In accordance with Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, a traffic regulation order is required for A41 London Road:

For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);

For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
