### Summary

The Local Government Pension Scheme Regulations permit an administering authority to exercise various discretions. Buckinghamshire Pension Fund's last Statement of Discretions was published in relation to the Local Government Pension Scheme Regulations 2007/2008. The Local Government Pension Scheme Regulations 2013 introduced new discretions and this report details the revised discretions statement, approved by Pension Fund Committee on 11 September 2014, to incorporate these changes.
