### **Background and Summary**

There have been a number of reviews of the Transport service and specifically the TfB contract that have been undertaken over the last couple of years both internally, as a result of audits and as a result of enquiries from various committees including the Regulatory and Audit Committee. There were a number of outputs that resulted from these reviews that need to be considered and addressed by the service. An improvement plan was pulled together and monitored. In April Ruth Vigour-Hedderly became Cabinet Member for Transport and instructed Gate One to undertake a full Health Check on the contract between RJ and BCC. As a result of the outcomes of this Health Check and being very mindful of the improvement plan that needed to be developed a Transformation Program was developed with RJ. The details of this project are included in Appendix 1 along with an update of progress. For completeness and due to the interdependency of the outcomes of the ETL Committee and this Committee the report submitted to the ETL Committee earlier this month including the supplementary papers are included in Appendix 2.
