1. Purpose of Report

1.1 To provide Members with options for consideration to change the existing tariffs and parking restrictions in Great Missenden. This affects two car parks; Link Road and Buryfield.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 Members consider the introduction of an additional tariff on the aforementioned car parks.
- 2.2 That if Item 2.1 a) and 2.1 b) above are agreed the Head of Legal Services be authorised to publish the necessary Legal Notice proposing to make the Amendment Order
- 2.3 That if no valid objections are received the Director of Services be authorised to make and publicise the Amendment Order as drafted
- 2.4 That if valid objections are received, the Director of Services be authorised to deal with any such objections after consultation with the Portfolio Holder and to make and publicise the Amendment Order with or without modifications as appropriate.

3. Content of the Report

- 3.1 The demand for parking in Great Missenden has considerably increased. The result of which is that motorists wishing to park to visit the local amenities are struggling to find available parking space. The crux of the problem is that car parking space is taken up by commuters who park all day and therefore reduce the turnover of spaces, thus limiting the availability.
- 3.2 The two council car parks have a total of 114 parking spaces, 5 of which are disabled bays. The tariffs range from one hour free to £3.50 for over 4 hours. Specific information for each car park is provided in Table 1.

- 3.3 Great Missenden Train Station is approximately three minutes' walk from the council car parks. The daily parking tariff at the station is £6.50 peak time. This is a difference of £3 per day compared to the Council's daily tariff.
- 3.4 Based on recent ticket purchases on Link Road car park where all parking is chargeable, the highest number of sales in any one band is long stay at 34%. This represents one third of the parking spaces on the car park. In addition to the daily sales there are a number of permits holders which increase the long stay daily ratio to 45%.
- 3.5 A survey of Link Road and Buryfield car parks in April 2016 show that the occupancy level on Link Road is in excess of 95% on most days; Buryfield is slightly less at 80%, although on some days the occupancy levels rise to 97%. These figures increase during school holidays.

4. Options

4.1 To address the parking problems in Great Missenden Members are asked to consider an additional tariff band of 9 hours. Details of which are set out in Table 2.

A tariff of over 9 hours priced at 50p below the train station parking charge enables local workers to continue paying the current long stay parking fee of £3.50 whilst deterring some commuters without removing this income stream altogether

5. Consultation

5.1 Discussions have taken place with ward councillors, Great Missenden Parish Council, and Great Missenden Village Association Committee. All are in favour of an additional tariff band.

5.2 The report has been circulated for internal circulation. No concerns were raised.

6. Legal Implications

6.1 Changing the tariff band structure requires an amendment to the Off Street Parking Places Order. Appendix A sets out the process.

7. Financial Implications

7.1 Costs associated with the recommendations can be seen in Table 3. Also provided is the expected additional income should the recommendations be implemented.
