9 **Performance Indicator Review 2019/20**

(a) DECISION:

The Cabinet received a report which updated Members on the outcomes of the Performance Indicator (PI) review for 2019/20 and which sought approval for the proposed changes to reporting.

RESOLVED that the changes to the Performance Indicators for each service be approved.

(b) REASON FOR DECISION:

Reviewing Performance Indicators allowed each service to adjust targets, add in more relevant indicators and remove those indicators that did not provide valuable information so that the Indicators were relevant and up to date. Performance Indicators were part of the Service Planning process, and serve as an important part of the Council's performance management framework.

11 **CCTV Review**

(a) DECISION:

The Cabinet received a report which advised on the recommendations of the Healthy Communities Policy Advisory Group following a review of CCTV cameras in the district.

RESOLVED

- 1. That the recommendations from the Healthy Communities Policy Advisory Group following the review of CCTV in the district be noted**
- 2. That the bringing forward of expenditure up to £210,000 from the allocated Capital budget 2019/20 to 2023/24 for the replacement of the current 42 CCTV cameras with digital units be agreed.**
- 3. That authority be delegated to the Head of Healthy Communities to carry out the procurement and to make a decision on the final contract for the replacement of CCTV equipment in accordance with the Council's contract procedure rules.**
- 4. That authority be delegated to the Head of Healthy Communities in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Healthy Communities to decide on the location of any relocated or new public realm CCTV cameras.**

(b) REASON FOR DECISION:

To reduce crime and disorder, improve public safety and support the safeguarding of vulnerable persons and to inform the Privacy Impact Assessment as required by the Information Commissioner Office.

(c) ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:

- To retain/replace a different number of CCTV units.
- To decide against the use of planned mobile CCTV units in hotspot areas for crime and disorder.
