1. Purpose of Report

RECOMMENDED -

- 1. That the case for a shared Business Support Service is proven and that both Councils should proceed to establish a shared Business Support Service
- 2. That subject to consultation with staff and a formal agreement between the Councils, the services of staff in South Bucks District Council's Business Support Service be put at the disposal of Chiltern District Council under Section 113 of the Local Government Act 1972 so they can work across the two local authority areas.
- 3. That the Chief Executive in consultation with the Cabinet Leader and the Head of Legal and Democratic Services be authorised to finalise the terms of any legal documentation required to give effect to recommendation 2 above.

2. Report Content

The Chiltern and South Bucks Joint Committee is due to consider the Business Case for a shared Business Support Service at its meeting on 20 July 2015. Any updates following this meeting will be tabled at the Council meeting.
