8 Solar Powered Bins

(a) DECISION:

The PAG received a report to explore the feasibility of using high-tech litter bins, which use solar power to compact waste, within South Bucks' town centres.

Having considered the advice of the PAG, the Portfolio Holder **RESOLVED** to approve two trials of solar powered compacting bins; one in Beaconsfield New Town and one in Denham Green shop parade, at a total cost of £2900, from the existing budget for litter bin repairs.

(b) REASON FOR DECISION:

- Solar powered compacting bins offer efficiencies in reduced collection requirements, improved street scene and real time fill monitoring.
- A 6 week trial will provide sufficient data to see if benefits can be achieved in South Bucks and feed into the consideration of future waste collection arrangements.

(c) ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:

The following options were considered:

- a) To use a different trial area or trial criteria, such as a greater or lesser number of units (it was noted that 5 units are required as a minimum by the manufacturer);
- b) To not approve a trial but suggest that existing assets are reviewed;
