
## **Report to the Thames Valley Police & Crime Panel**



1. The Panel has a statutory duty to handle non-criminal complaints against the Police & Crime Commissioner for Thames Valley.

2. A Sub-Committee of the Panel discharges this duty on its behalf. The Chairman of the Sub-Committee is currently Cllr. Emily Culverhouse.

3. It was agreed that the Sub-Committee should submit its report to the Panel at the next scheduled public meeting of the Panel following resolution of a complaint.

## **Complaints Received**

4. One complaint was considered at Sub-Committee meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2015.

- 5 The complaint related to the PCC not meeting the complainant and also there was a complaint of corruption and lying in public office. The Sub-Committee agreed that the complaint did not fall within the jurisdiction of the Panel as set out in the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Complaints and Misconduct) Regulations 2012.
- 6. There are no further meetings of the Sub-Committee currently planned.
