### **Background**

1. The Panel has a statutory duty to handle non-criminal complaints against the Police & Crime Commissioner for Thames Valley.
2. A Sub-Committee of the Panel discharges this duty on its behalf. The Chairman of the Sub-Committee is currently Cllr. Emily Culverhouse.
3. It was agreed that the Sub-Committee should submit its report to the Panel at the next scheduled public meeting of the Panel following resolution of a complaint.

### **Complaints Received**

4. One complaint was considered at Sub-Committee meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2015.
5. The complaint related to the PCC not meeting the complainant and also there was a complaint of corruption and lying in public office. The Sub-Committee agreed that the complaint did not fall within the jurisdiction of the Panel as set out in the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Complaints and Misconduct) Regulations 2012.
6. There are no further meetings of the Sub-Committee currently planned.
