7 **Summer Youth Diversionary Projects**

(a) DECISION:

The PAG received a report which asked Members to consider allocating £2,250 to support voluntary youth organisations in delivering diversionary activities throughout the summer school holiday periods.

Having considered the advice of the PAG, the Portfolio Holder **RESOLVED:**

- 1) That £2,250 be allocated to support voluntary youth organisations in delivering diversionary activities throughout the summer school holiday periods.

(b) REASON FOR DECISION:

To support youth organisations to offer a range of accessible diversionary activities during the school holidays. During the summer holiday period many voluntary youth sector organisations suspend their programmes resulting in young people having limited access to positive activities which can increase the likelihood of anti-social and disruptive behaviours.

(c) ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:

To not allocate any funding, which could result in an inconsistent level of support for young people over the summer holiday period.

8 Chiltern & South Bucks Playing Pitch Strategy

(a) DECISION:

The PAG received a report on the draft Chiltern and South Bucks Council Playing Pitch Strategy which asked members to approve the draft strategy to be circulated for public consultation with Town and Parish Councils, sports clubs and other agencies.

Having considered the advice of the PAG, the Porfolio Holder **RESOLVED:**

- 1) To agree to undertake public consultation on the draft South Bucks and Chiltern Playing Pitch Strategy.

(b) REASON FOR DECISION:

The Chiltern and South Bucks Playing Pitch Strategy is a key document in helping inform the new Local Plan.

Improving access and the quality of sports local playing pitch provision contributes directly to improving the health and wellbeing of residents. An up to date audit of South Bucks existing sports playing pitches will enable Town and Parish Councils, sports clubs and local community groups to identify the priorities for improvement and enable organisations to plan and attract inward investment.

(c) ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:

To not agree to the public consultation being undertaken or to request further amendments to the draft document be made prior to public consultation.
