Reason for the Decision:	To allow Public Spaces Protection Order or Orders (PSPOs) within Wycombe District Council area to be made without reference to Cabinet, will reduce delays and administrative burdens allowing arrangements to be implemented quickly and efficiently.			
Proposed Decision/Recommendation:	That: (i) Authority be delegated to the Head of Environment, Housing and Communities to make PSPOs within the Wycombe District Council area.			
Sustainable Community Strategy/Council Priorities - Implications	PSPOs contribute to the Council's priority of People and Place by working with and engaging with local communities to deal with and reduce anti-social behaviour which in turn contributes to making the district a place people want live, work and visit.			
Monitoring Officer/ S.151 Officer Comments	Monitoring Officer: The Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 empowers a local authority to make PSPOs in certain circumstances. Under section 101(1)(a) of the Local Government Act 1972, a local authority may arrange for the discharge of their functions by a committee, sub-committee or an officer. This delegation will enable the decision whether to make a PSPO to be made by the named Officer S.151 Officer: Any costs incurred will need to be met from within existing budgets.			

Consultees:	Consultation for High Wycombe's PSPOs includes public surveys and consultation letters to the Police and Crime Commissioner, Police Superintendent, Eden Shopping Centre, Oasis & SMART (drug and alcohol treatment agencies), MP Steve Baker, High Wycombe BIDCo, WDC Councillors.
Options:	Not to delegate authority which will require individual proposed PSPOs to be considered by cabinet
Next Steps:	When necessary the Head of Environment, Housing and Communities will make and implement PSPOs as necessary.
