**County Highway Authority –** Having assessed the proposed development using the Buckinghamshire Countywide Parking Guidance policy document, I note that both the existing and proposed developments require 6 parking spaces. Given the development does not increase the parking requirement for the site, the Highway Authority does not object to this application on grounds of insufficient parking provision.

**Conservation Officer Spatial Planning -** No impact on conservation area. Application is in accordance with policy DM31 of the WLP 2019.
