Unfortunately, following my appointment in October 2013 I discovered that whilst the decision on the definitive boundary marked to where the revised boundary should actually lie after the decision the boundary should lie and it is my intention to take this back to the committee so that they can

Mr Holmes has provided me with a map where he has drawn (The green line is the existing boundary, the blue line is the footpath and then across to complete an area which would be incorporated into Lacey Green and set by the hedge and the public footpath.

The plan is to put this proposal before the next Regulatory & Appeals Committee which is due

Can I ask for your comments as to Mr Holmes proposal so that I can take this forward?

As an aside it is also proposed to make an application to the Local Government Boundary Commission to merge the two properties into the District of Lacey Green and the Hampdens away from Greater Hughenden for the application to be made.
