Buckinghamshire Council Annual Report

(a) Decisions

RESOLVED –

That the achievements of the Council in 2020-2021 against the objectives outlined in the Buckinghamshire Council Corporate Plan 2020-2023 be noted.

(b) Reasons for decisions

As the first year of the new Buckinghamshire Council comes to a close, an annual report has been produced to recognise the (non-Covid related) achievements of the Council against our corporate objectives. This report sits alongside a complementary 'Our Covid Response Report 2020-2021' which highlights the achievements specifically in relation to the pandemic response.

(c) Alternative options considered

Not to draft an annual report. However, this would not provide an opportunity to reflect and share publicly the scale of the work delivered over the last year.

It was felt that in a year where the Covid-19 pandemic had to many felt all encompassing, focussing on non-Covid work allowed an opportunity to reflect on the huge scale of work delivered in spite of the pandemic.
